



NJ TRANSIT INFORMATIONAL PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

The New Jersey Transit Corporation (NJ TRANSIT), in accordance with Section 5 of P.L. 1984 c.578 of SCDRTAP, is conducting a public hearing to gather information and receive comments from interested parties concerning programs developed pursuant to the Senior Citizen & Disabled Residents Transportation Assistance Program (SCDRTAP) Act. **Additionally, each hearing will be available both in-person and virtually and will cover the southern, central, and northern regions of New Jersey. The in-person hearings will be held in Iselin, Blackwood, and Newark, NJ.**

SCDRTAP funds support capital, operating, and administrative costs for local transportation services for seniors and people with disabilities. The program also funds accessibility improvements to NJ TRANSIT's fixed route services, provides technical assistance to counties, and supports statewide program administration.
